

## Quarantine Options per CDC, OSDH, & WPS

If your child is identified as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 at school, you have 3 quarantine options:

**1. 14-day quarantine, return day 15**

**2. 10-day quarantine, return day 11**

**a. Requires no symptoms**

**b. No test**

**c. MUST WEAR A MASK THROUGH DAY 14**

**3. 7-day quarantine, return day 8**

**a. Requires no symptoms**

**b. A negative test on day 5, 6, or 7**

**c. MUST WEAR A MASK THROUGH DAY 14.**

**\*\*Important dates to remember.\*\***

If your student has been exposed to COVID-19, they should not test before day 5, 6, or 7 from their exposure date, unless they are “sick” or experiencing symptoms. Testing too early may lead to a false negative.
